Identifying if your Land Cruiser LCIOO has a VNT Turbo



Unfortunately, it is not as simple as referencing the model year. We have seen many older Land Cruiser IOO series with the older style ECU that has a VNT turbo fitted as standard.

It seems Toyota raided the parts bin and started testing modern technology before it was due to be released into the 2002 & onwards model.

The easiest way to identify a VNT turbo is the vacuum canister, which will be mounted 90° to the turbo boost control solenoid.

If you have a conventional wastegate actuator (no vacuum canister present), then you'll need to purchase the Unichip Boost Control Kit to get the full potential from Unichip upgrade. You may also use the Boost Control Kit + Unichip to control an aftermarket turbo, instead of a VNT unit.
